


- Residential experience as a leader (either in the UK or abroad)
- Experience of international travel (either privately or within guiding)
- Available to travel during Easter 2019 or late July/early August 2019
- Available to attend a briefing weekend from 31 August to 2 September at Girlguiding North West England HQ, Preston
- Aged 18+ by 1 July 2019
- Available to attend the girls' selection weekend on Friday 6 July to Sunday 8 July

Girlguiding North West England will provide a grant to cover some of the essential costs for leaders running Region international trips.

The deadline for applications is Friday 16 February 2018. Places are limited and will be offered on a first-come, first-served basis. You will be notified by the Wednesday 21 February whether you have been invited to attend.
