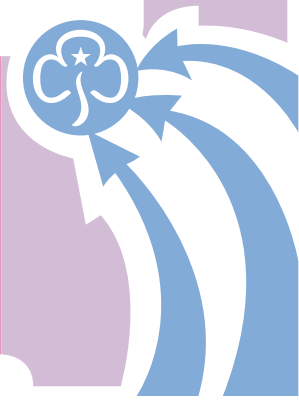

Are you a Senior Section member interested in exploring new possibilities within guiding? Then the peer educator basic training is a perfect opportunity to learn new skills and find out how you can get involved with other sections. This exciting training is aimed at Senior Section members, aged 14–26, who would like to learn the skills to be able to lead fun and informative sessions for other sections. The peer educator basic training is led by peer educator trainers who have completed many trainings before. In addition you will need to attend a specific topic training session to qualify as a peer educator. WHAT IS A PEER EDUCATOR? A peer educator is a Senior Section member, aged up to 26 years old, who can run sessions on a range of different topics including; gender stereotyping, mental resilience, body confidence and self-esteem. Sessions can be for Brownies, Guides, other Senior Section members and even leaders! You can also run sessions outside of guiding.
