Easter Activities



Tissue Paper Animal Jars

You will need....

- Glue
- Tissue paper white for a bunny or yellow for a chick
- Chick googly eyes and yellow card
- Bunny pom-pom, googly eyes, pipe cleaners and coloured card

Instructions:

Chick:

- 1. Start by covering your jar in a layer of tissue paper.
- 2. Cut out two wings and a beak from yellow card.
- 3. Once the jar is dry, attach the googly eyes, wings, and beak.

Bunny:

- 1. Start by covering your jar in a layer of tissue paper.
- 2. Cut out the ears from the coloured card.
- 3. Once the jar is dry, attach the pom-pom for the tail, googly eyes, pipe cleaners for the whiskers and ears.

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Chocolate Chicks:

You will need...

- Orange chocolate buttons
- Milk chocolate buttons.
- White chocolate buttons
- Chocolate eggs, e.g. cream eggs
- Milk chocolate, e.g. Cadbury.
- Black icing pen

- 1. Place two orange buttons on a plate and scoop a tiny amount of chocolate on top of the buttons.
- 2. Stick down the chocolate egg on top of the orange buttons.
- 3. Stick one milk button either side of the chocolate egg to make it look like wings.
- 4. Stick one milk button on the back of the egg to make it look like a tail.
- 5. Stick two white chocolate buttons on the front of the egg to make it look like eyes.
- 6. Snap one button into the shape of a beak and attach this under the eyes.
- 7. Use the icing pen to make a dot in each of the white chocolate buttons. This is to represent eyes.



Concertina Chick Decoration:

You will need...

- Coloured card
- White card
- Coloured ribbon mixed if possible
- Googly eyes.
- Craft feathers.
- Double-sided tape
- Sticky tape

- 1. Place an A4 piece of yellow card landscape and begin to draw vertical lines 3cm apart from each other.
- 2. Concertina fold along your vertical lines. When you get to the end, fold in half and stick the edges together using double sided tape to create fan shapes. Repeat steps 1 and 2 so that you have 2 fan shapes.
- 3. Using double-sided tape stick both concertina fans together to create a concertina circle.
- 4. Using the template draw around and cut out both sides of the eggshell from white card, and the beak, and wings from orange card.
- 5. Stick both sides of the eggshell onto the concertina circle leaving space in between for the eyes and beak.
- 6. Stick the beak on the centre of the concertina circle and 2 wiggle eyes above. Make sure the wiggle eyes are stuck onto two ridges of the concertina folds.
- 7. Stick an orange feather onto each wing.
- 8. Pinch the bottom of each wing together so that it can be stuck around one of the concertina folds at the back of the chick. Using both double-sided tape and sticky tape will make the wings more secure. Alternatively, you can use hot glue.
- 9. Cut a length of ribbon onto each wing approximately 30cm.
- 10. Create a loop in the ribbon and stick to the back of the chick. Using both double-sided tape and sticky tape will make the loop more secure.



Beaded Chick Keyring:

You will need...

- White elastic
- Coloured beads
- Colourful pony beads
- Split metal rings

- 1. To start, cut a length of white elastic (64cm).
- 2. Starting from the middle of the elastic, thread both ends through 3 yellow beads.
- 3. Next, thread both ends of the elastic through 4 beads in the sequence of; 1 yellow bead, 2 black beads and 1 yellow bead.
- 4. Thread both ends through 3 beads in the sequence of; 1 yellow bead, 1 orange bead and 1 yellow bead.
- 5. To start the body of the chick, thread both ends of the elastic through 4 yellow beads.
- 6. For the wings, thread 3 yellow beads onto one of the ends of elastic. Pull the elastic back through the middle bead only.
- 7. Thread another yellow bead onto the same elastic. Thread the elastic back through the previous row of 4 yellow beads.
- 8. Repeat previous steps on the other side of the chick to create 2 wings.
- 9. Finish the rest of the chick's body by threading both ends of the elastic through 4 yellow beads and then thread both ends of elastic through 3 yellow beads.
- 10. For the foot, thread an orange bead onto one end of the elastic, loop it back through the first yellow bead on the previous row of yellow beads and tie a knot.
- 11. Repeat for the other side by looping the other length of elastic through the last bead in the previous row of yellow beads.
- 12. Trim the elastic.
- 13. To finish, loop a split metal ring on the elastic at the top of the chick.

Chocolate Easter Nests:

To make 12 easter nest, you will need...

- 225g milk or plan cooking chocolate
- 50g butter
- 2 tbsp golden syrup
- 70g cornflakes
- Mini eggs (2-3 per nest)
- Paper cupcake cases

Instructions:

- 1. Melt the chocolate, butter, and syrup together in either the microwave or in a bowl over a simmering pan of hot water.
- 2. Mix the cornflakes until they are fully covered by the chocolate mix.
- 3. Lay out the paper cases and add in some cornflakes mix to each one to make a nest.
- 4. Add 2-3 mini eggs on the top of each nest.
- 5. Allow the chocolate easter nests to cool for a few minutes in the fridge to set them.

Egg and Spoon Race

You will need...

- Eggs
- Spoons

- 1. Give each child an egg and a spoon.
- 2. Set up a course with a starting point and a finishing line.
- 3. Have them a race to the finish line without dropping the egg.

Easter Paper Chains:

You will need...

- Coloured card
- Googly eyes.
- Mini glue dots
- Coloured ribbon
- Scissors
- Coloured pens, e.g. sharpies

- 1. Cut 7 strips of card, each 5cm wide, along the short edge.
- 2. Take one strip and staple the ends together to make the first link.
- 3. For the second link, thread the strip through the first link and staple the ends together.
- 4. Cut out the characters face and feet.
- 5. Assemble the face pieces and attach them to the top loop using glue. Stick the feet to the bottom loop and add a hanging thread.
